### Active Kids

The NSW Government is helping kids get active with the new Active Kids program. From 31 January 2018, parents, guardians and carers can apply for a \$100 voucher per calendar year for each student enrolled in school.

The voucher may be used with a registered activity provider for registration, participation and membership costs for sport, fitness and active recreation activities. The voucher can be used at any time during the calendar year it was issued. To use the voucher, give your voucher details to an approved Active Kids Provider. The program runs year-round, so kids can get active at any time! The following link will direct you to apply on-line:

### School Voluntary Contribution & Book Packs

Each year we ask our school community for a voluntary school contribution. The amount for these contributions is not set by the school but instead by the DoE. For 2018 the contribution is \$30 per child or \$50 per family. This voluntary contribution can be sent to the office in an envelope marked "School Voluntary Contribution" (Also known as school fees). In past years the P&C has very kindly paid for the Student Book Packs / On-line subscriptions, however it has been decided that this year due to the level of fundraising support, that the responsibility has been placed back to families.
