3D Printing

Last Tuesday our whole school learned about 3D printing.

The name of our teacher for 3D printing was Mrs Lollback, who was teaching us. She was also training the teachers! We learned how to control the 3D printer using the computer. The program is called TinkerCad. It is an online program. She typed information into the program and designed a bilby. The 3D printer then used a special coil of cord called a filament. It was white and it looked like whipper snipper cord. When the cord was being used it smelled a bit like burnt plastic. We all thought the little bilby was so cute! We were amazed because of the fine texture of the lines on the bilby. Our first project is to design and make a name tag. We will all work together with our Learning Buddies, so everyone, Kinder to Year 6, is involved.

At the end of our first lesson we all felt happy and excited about learning how to design and print 3D objects!
