Bean and Corn Salsa

1 can black beans drained and rinsed
1 can corn drained
3 medium tomato diced
1 capsicum diced
1 red onion diced
3 clove garlic minced
1 handful of finely chopped parsley
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup olive oil
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup red wine vinegar
fresh juice from 1 lime
Salt & pepper to taste

Combine all ingredients in a large bowl, mix and serve.

Chicken Taco Salad

1 bbq chicken shredded
300g grated cheese
1 iceberg lettuce shredded
3 carrots grated
1 bag of corn chips crushed

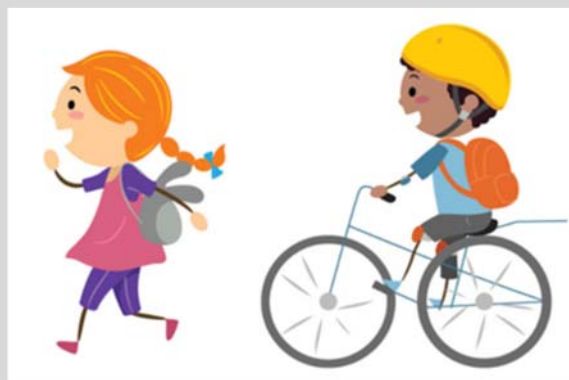
